ARRIVE Keene High Auditorium & check-in with chaperone.
(Please see tech/dress rehearsal schedule for specific times)

All dancers must arrive *in costume* with hair in a bun or pulled off face if too short & light make-up, see make up & hair in newsletter, no jewelry.

This is a great time to practice getting everything just right for the show.
This may be only yours and their first or second time doing this, it takes a bit of time!

FINISH: *pick up dancer at hallway (backstage) door, check-out w/chaperone.*
Please Note Finish time is estimate only, rehearsal may run over.

If rehearsals run a little late please be patient, it's all for the best!

Creative & Combo Performance Arrival time is 6:30 pm

(This is 15 minutes later than older dancers, will allow a smoother check-in for you & your dancer).

Please bring your child to the backstage area, **IN COSTUME** & check-in with chaperone.

All Creative & Combo dancers will be going out to watch the second half show during intermission. At intermission parents will need to go get their dancers and bring them to sit with you for the second half of the show. The dancers will only be backstage for about 1 hour and they will have special chaperones just for them! Please do not worry as they will be very well looked after!

If your dancer has any special toy or other activity they enjoy feel free to bring it along with their name on it, in a bag. All items, shoes and clothing should have dancers name!

Snacks and water will be provided by donation for all dancers.

You will be given a complimentary ticket for your dancing child to sit with you for the remainder of the show when you purchase your tickets to the show.

Inform office persons that you have a creative/combo dancer when making your ticket purchase. Office persons have a list of all Creative & Combo dancers, but please make sure to mention it as well, to make sure you receive a ticket/seat for your dancer with your seat!

Show Times: Year end performance times: 7 pm for the two evening shows. Dancers need to arrive at 6:15pm. Theatre doors will open at 6:30pm.

Show Rehearsal Week:

A Schedule for the Tech/Dress rehearsals is included in performance packet. Dancers must arrive at rehearsal one half hour prior to their scheduled tech rehearsal times and check in with the chaperone. Performers may leave when their last number is over. Tech/Dress rehearsals run in order of the show. Please be patient & understand that scheduled times are approximate and every effort is made to keep on schedule, rehearsals may run over allotted times. It is mandatory to attend every required rehearsal, absent

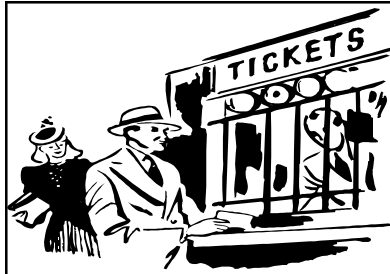
students may forfeit their performing opportunity. This is when performers get used to spacing, lighting, and timing. *It is unfair to other performers if a performer misses their rehearsal and then is allowed to perform.*

Tech/Dress Rehearsal:

Costumes must be worn for the Tech/Dress Rehearsals, hair in a bun & all required accessories to your costume must be worn as well! Make-up must be worn as well! See accessories list for more make-up info.

Rehearsal Procedure Please Note:

Tech/Dress Rehearsal will be run from backstage. All Performers must remain backstage at all times. No one will be permitted into the theatre during dress rehearsal. This is when the lighting & sound people rehearse as well and it is very difficult to rehearse when there are people in the theatre. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

Please see persons in the office for costume extras or if you have any questions regarding your child's accessories.

Make sure you have all accessories needed for your costumes prior to Dress/Tech rehearsals as you need to be in FULL costume and makeup!

Dancers must have real *dance* tights, shoes and/or slippers.

Nylons and gymnastic/bedroom type slippers are not allowed on *any dancer*.

Hair supplies are also available in MPAA's store!

Hair and Make up

Basic Make-up for Rehearsals & Performances:

Foundation, (as there will be very bright lighting that will wash out skin color), blush, eye-liner, soft red lipstick. Optional: mascara, natural colored eye-shadow.

Please, no glitter, as this makes dancers look sweaty onstage, not glittery!

Chaperones will be checking hair & make-up, dancers must look neat & professional.

Remember, NO jewelry whatsoever! No Nail or Toe Polish!

Hair for Rehearsals & Performances:

All long hair must be secured in a bun with invisible hair net and hairpins. If hair is short, it still must be secured away from face, (this means bangs off of face, adults too).

Please use hair nets, clips and accessories that match dancers own hair color.

Boys please comb hair neatly, light hair spray if necessary.

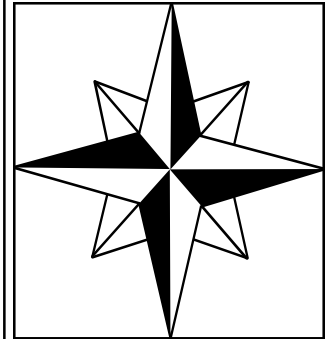

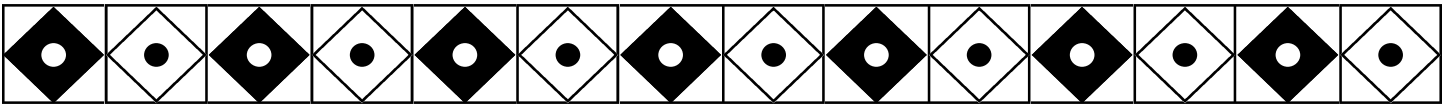
